

Bonding Course

Course Aim

To train staff in all aspects of Bonding Duties

The training will consist of :-

1. Knowledge of the different types of Bonds used in the Traction Return System.
2. Familiarisation with Bonding Diagrams.
3. Training in the safe use of the small tools and plant used.
4. Practical experience in fitting various types of Bond.
5. Practical assessment
6. Theory assessment.

The maximum number of delegates is 8.

The duration of the course is 3 days.

Objective

At the end of the course the delegates will be able to identify the various types of bonds and their function. They will also be competent in the installation of these bonds and the small tools and plant which are used in this process.

NOTE- THIS COURSE DOES NOT INCLUDE THE REMOVAL OR INSTALLATION OF RED BONDS. THIS IS A SEPARATE COURSE AND DELEGATES MUST HOLD CURRENT SENTINEL NOMINATED PERSON STATUS.

Competence

Successful delegates will receive an Aspire rail competency card.

Entry Qualifications

Delegates must hold a valid Sentinel Track Safety Card (PTS) and also hold a valid Sentinel AP OLE AC/i competency. They must meet the required medical standards for persons detailed in Network Rail Specification NR/L2/CTM/021. It is also required the delegates comply with the requirements of NR/L1/OHS/051-Drugs and Alcohol. The delegates suitability to attend the course must be assessed by the sponsor of the person concerned.
