

Protection Controller (PC)

Course Aim

To train staff in the duties of a PC

The training will consist off:

1. Introduction to the roles of PC
2. Procedure for blocking the line and arranging protection
3. Starting work, during work, change of PC/COSS/IWA
4. When work is completed or suspended
5. When work is not completed or suspended at agreed time, resumption of work
6. Theory Assessment
7. Practical Assessment
8. Post course training objectives

The maximum number of delegates on this course is 8; the course duration is 1 day

Objective

To enable suitably qualified staff to carry out duties of a Protection Controller (PC) as set out in module T2 of the Rule Book and competence requirements of Network Rail Specifications NR/L2/CTM/021

Competence

The training will be followed by theory and practical assessments. Results will be forwarded by the training provider to the NCCA for Sentinel Track Safety Cards to be issued.

Entry Qualifications

All delegates must have a minimum of having carried out 6 COSS duties over the previous six months; documentary evidence from previous COSS briefing forms is required.
