

Person in Charge of Possession (PICOP)

Course Aim

This course is intended to meet the requirement of Network Rail Specification NR/L2/CTM/021

The training will consist of:

1. Introduction to PICOP
2. Possession process and planning meetings
3. Possession details
4. Communicating clearly
5. Taking the possession
6. Setting up of a worksite/Sites of work
7. Train movements
8. Changeover procedure
9. Suspension off/Handing back of worksite or sites of work
10. Giving up possession
11. Review and T4 possessions
12. Theory assessment
13. Practical/Verbal assessment
14. Completion of post course training objectives

The maximum number of delegates for the course is 6, the course is over 3 days, re-certification is 1 day.

Objective

To enable suitably qualified staff to carry out PICOP Duties as set out in module T3 of the rule book and relevant rule standards

Competence

The training will be followed by theory and practical assessments. Results will be forwarded by the training provider to the NCCA for Sentinel Track Safety Cards to be issued.

Entry Qualifications

Applicants for PICOP training must hold a valid Sentinel Track Safety Card (PTS) and meet the required medical standards for persons detailed in Network Rail Specification NR/L2/CTM/021
